INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC ACADEMY BACKGROUND

Our Vision

The Hazel Glen College Instrumental Music Academy (*IMA*) has been established to identify and develop emerging student musicians across all facets and disciplines of instrumental music. The Academy's holistic approach aims to develop the student musicians to better prepare individuals for pathways into a professional setting by supporting them to balance their academics, develop their leadership skills and support them to become global citizens.

Our Mission

- To promote a high performance culture that provides student musicians the skills to be successful and foster a love for music
- To develop, enhance and prepare students for pathway opportunities into professional settings
- To assist student musicians to balance their academic and instrumental goals, and develop mental and technical skills that will support them to achieve and reach their potential

Instrumental Music Academy

Students will participate in 3 X 60 - minute sessions per week that are a combination of timetabled, instrumental and after school classes. Student musicians will follow a high performance curriculum that will further deepen and support their musical success in and out of the classroom. The Instrumental Music Academy is a 2 year program for student musicians starting in Year 5 and requires a 2 year commitment.

• The Academy will have 25 positions available for Year 5 students and 25 positions available for Year 6 students in 2024.

Stage 1 of Application: Written Application

Student Musicians must complete all sections of the IMA Written Application and submit a <u>hardcopy</u> to the College's Main Office <u>before 4:00pm, Thursday 27th June 2024</u>. There will **be no accepted application after the above date and time.**

Student Musicians who are successful in reaching Stage 2 of their IMA Application will be notified via email sent by <u>ima@hazelglencollege.com</u>. (If an email is not received by 4pm on Monday 1st July, your application has not been successful.)

✓ Please remove pages 1-5 before handing in your application.

Below is a checklist of the required sections needing completion and documentation to be attached to your IMA Application prior to handing it to the main office.

- Contact details and any rehearsal schedules of Student Musician
- Teacher or tutor reference (Please attach to Written Application)
- Academic and behavioural school reports for the last 12 months of education (*Please attach photocopies*)

Stage 2 of Application: Student Video Submission

Student Musicians who are successful in their completion of Stage 1 of their IMA Application will be notified via email as listed above. A maximum of 25 Student Musicians will be successful in reaching Stage 2.

Video Submission

Successful Student Musicians from Stage 1 will submit a short video showcasing their passion for music and leadership. *This does not have to be in the form of an audition.* Students may want to talk about their dedication to groups, clubs or hobbies to demonstrate their passion. Students are encouraged to be creative with their submissions. **All video submissions must be emailed to ima@hazelglencollege.com by Monday 5th July 4pm.** Below are the guidelines:

- Video length no longer than 5 minutes
- May include performance piece
- Video file must be saved as MP4 or MOV
- Video file must be emailed to: ima@hazelglencollege.com

Stage 3 of Application: Musician Interview

Interview

The final step in the application process *may require* an interview for those successful at stage 2, with the Instrumental Music Academy Leader and Director of Music. This is an event that will be held on **Thursday 18th July from 4-6pm** inside the Hazel Glen Performing Arts Center. This event can only be attended by Student Musicians. Below is a breakdown of the Interview:

✓ Student Passion: Prospective Student Musicians will need to describe to the interviewers why they wish to be part of the IMA. Students should consider how they can contribute as leaders within the school community, work as part of a team within their IMA class and College Ensemble Program/s, and individual goals for their own musicianship. Students may want to show their current ability on an instrument but this is not required.



✓ Question and Answer: Students will have a chance to ask the interviewers questions about the program and talk about what they would be interested in doing in the IMA. Interviewers will have some time to ask Student Musicians any final questions.

*Please note that some applicants may **not** need to attend the interview stage dependent on their stage 1 and 2 applications.

SUCCESSFUL + UNSUCCESSFUL LETTERS

Once the Interview has concluded, **13 letters of offer** will be emailed to successful applicants. Positions will be offered after careful consideration of combining Questions and Answer, Student Passion, the IMA Written Application, References, and previous school reports. Both successful and unsuccessful Emails will be sent out on **Friday July 19th at 4:00PM.** *If unsuccessful, information will be provided regarding the opportunity to join the Instrumental Music Program (IMP) for 2024.*

✓ Successful student musicians and families will then be required to complete the Instrumental Music Academy Student Agreement attached to the successful email. This contract can be provided to an IMA teacher at the start of Week 2, Term 3.
